**General Guidelines:**

- All medication (prescription and non-prescription) must be for student only and must be in original container with label and/or directions clearly marked
- Place all medication and Medication Form in a Ziploc bag with student's name clearly written on outside
- One chaperone per bus will be assigned to secure and disperse all medication
- Upon check-in the day of departure, turn over medication to assigned chaperone by bus
- Inhalers and Epi-pens are to be kept with the student – please complete a Medication Form and turn-in to assigned chaperone by bus
- Generally, medication will be passed out each morning during breakfast. Students may make other arrangements with assigned chaperone.
- It is the responsibility of the student to take his/her medication when scheduled
- All medication will be returned to the students upon arrival in Canfield
