VII.U.7 Scales for all instruments are to be played evenly and smoothly, ascending and descending, one octave, **except for Bb soprano clarinet which plays two octaves**. Each tone of the scale should be at a speed of quarter note = 80-120 beats per minute.

Bass clef baritone and other non-transposing bass clef instruments use the scales for C instruments. Treble clef baritone uses scales for the Bb instruments.
