General Guidelines:

- Rx All medication (prescription and non-prescription) must be for the student only and must be in original container with label and/or directions clearly marked.
- Rx Place all medication and Medication Authorization Form in a Ziploc bag with student's name clearly written on outside.
- Rx A certified chaperone(s) will be assigned to secure and disperse all medication
- Rx Upon check-in the day, check-in all medication to chaperone(s) assigned to distribute medication during the trip.
- Rx Inhalers and EpiPens are to be kept with the student – please complete a Medication Authorization Form and check-in.
- Rx Generally, medication will be passed out each morning during breakfast. Students may make other arrangements with chaperone(s).
- Rx It is the responsibility of the student to take his/her medication when scheduled.
- Rx All medication will be returned to the students when we return back to Canfield.
